Re: University Avenue Street Reconstruction – (Andover C.P. 18-38)
Curb and Gutter Construction Schedule

Dear Resident:

Based upon the contractor's current schedule and weather permitting, concrete curb and gutter construction will start Monday, May 13th on the east side of University Avenue and will take 3-4 days.

If you live in Ham Lake:

Please make arrangements to move any vehicles, boats, trailers, etc. prior to Monday morning at 6:00 am that you need to use from Monday through Thursday as you will not be able to access your driveway once the curb is poured for three to four days so it has a chance to cure, or strengthen. Please plan on parking your vehicles **on one of the adjacent streets** if possible or on the west side of University Avenue. If you park on the west side of the road, once the curb has been poured on the east side of the road you will need to park on the east side to allow the curb to be poured on the west side but take care not to bump into the new curb. After a few days the contractor will ramp over the new curb with gravel so you may resume using your driveways for normal vehicle traffic (no heavy trucks or equipment).

If you live in Andover:

Please make arrangements to move any vehicles, boats, trailers, etc. prior to 6:00 am the day after the curb has been poured on the east side of the road that you need to use for the rest of the week as you will not be able to access your driveway once the curb is poured for three to four days so it has a chance to cure, or strengthen. Please plan on parking your vehicles **on one of the adjacent streets** if possible or on the east side of University Avenue. After a few days the contractor will ramp over the new curb with gravel so you may resume using your driveways for normal vehicle traffic (no heavy trucks or equipment).

Once the curb and gutter has been completed and prior to regaining use of your driveways (before they are ramped with gravel), **please continue to park on adjacent streets** or on the east side of University Avenue. Parking is limited to one side so the roadway can be left open as much as possible for traffic. Vehicles may be parked overnight on the street during this timeframe.
